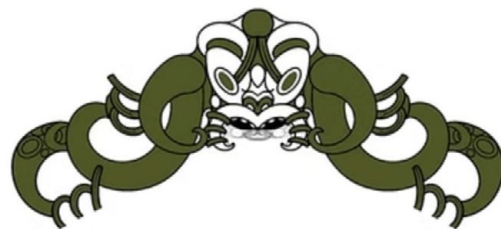

Why are we partnering with them?

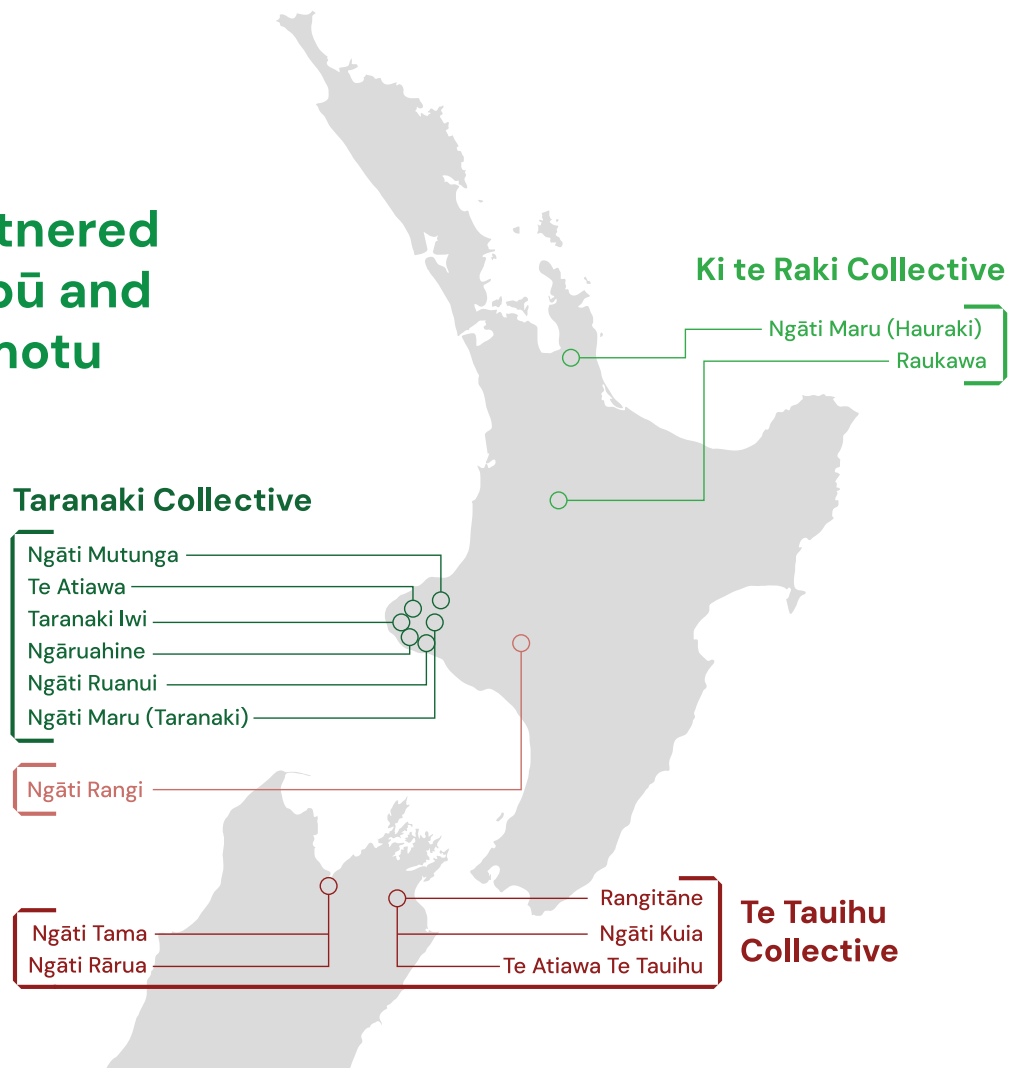
- Their kaupapa clearly lines up with our aspirations to see whānau thriving today and in the future.

What is Ka Uruora?

Ka Uruora is an iwi/Post Settlement Government Entity (PSGE) led kaupapa that exists to empower iwi whānau towards a prosperous and thriving future.

- Guided by iwi and whānau need.
- Support Māori on their journey to financial wellbeing and independence.
- Designed for whānau. This generation and the next.

What can Ka Uruora do for you?

At the launch event, Ka Uruora will be inviting hapū members to sign up for Te Uru Ahupūtea, their financial literacy programme. The first intake begins on 16 September 2025, and anyone who participates will be able to apply for Te Uru Kāinga, housing opportunities developed by Ka Uruora in our rohe.

Can I sign up if I don't go to the launch event?
